have their salaries as voted last year 148

3^d The Town by their vote Granted the sum of
Forty Pounds for the support of the Grammar school and 40
and ordered it to be kept as it was the last year
the Town by their vote Reconsidered their vote Respat
=ing the school, being kept in Landham School House
and voted that the school should be kept on the south
side of Landham Brook

4th The Town by their vote Granted the sum of Twenty
Pounds for the support of the Reading and writing 20
schools in the Town and ordered it to be kept as it was the
year past

5th The Town by their vote Granted the sum of Thirty
Pounds for the Relief of the poore in the Town the 30
Present year

6th The Town by their vote Appointed Benjamin Murry
to Take Care of and sweep the west Meeting House and
Big Gravel as there may be occasion Likewise Benjamin
Ball to do the like Business on the East side

7th The Town by their vote Granted the sum of four
Pounds to pay their Assessors the present year 4
Also Granted the sum of forty shillings to pay their
Town Treasurer the present year 2

8th it was put to vote to see if the Town would Take &
Support Capt John Haynes for the future and it past
in the Negative

9th it was put to vote to see if the Town would support
Moses Hayden and family for the future and the Town
by their vote Left it Discretionary to the Overseers
to do as they shall think proper

Then the Town by their vote Adjourned their meeting
till next Monday Comenite at One O'Clock in the
afternoon to this place
