These Order you to warn all the Freeholders and Other Inhabitants off and belonging to Sudbury in your Ward Qualified as the Law Directs to vote in Town Affairs to meet at the west Meeting House in Sudbury on Monday the Fifth Day of March Next at Ten O'Clock in the forenoon then and there

1st To Choose Selectmen, Town Clerk Town Treasurer Assessors Constables and all Other Town Officers as the Law Directs Annually to be Chosen in the month of March

2^d To see if the Town will Give Liberty for Horses to Go at Large without fetters any Part of the Time from the first of April to the Last of September the year ensuing

3^d To see if the Town will Repair their Highways by a Rate the Present year and Grant a suitable Sum of money for Repairing the same and Impower the Surveyors to be Collectors of said Rate also Order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith

4th To see if the Town will by their Vote Give Liberty for the Sheep to Go at Large in said Town any Part of the Time from the fifteenth Day of March Next to the first Day of May Next

5th To see if the Town will Give Liberty for the Swine to Go at Large in said Town the year ensuing

6th To see if the Town will Accept of the List of Jurors as Put into the Box by the Selectmen

7th To see if the Town will Grant and Confirm to Obadiah Perry about Ten Acres of Land he Bought of the Towns Committee agreeable to the Plan of the same and Order the same to be Recorded

8th To see if the Town will Give Instructions to their Overseers that shall be Chosen the Present year

9th To see if the Town will Accept of a Road laid out by the Selectmen from the Gravel Pit to west meadow so called agreeable to the Return of the Selectmen

10th To see if the Town will Order the School in the Southwest Part of the Town to be kept in the New School House near Mr. Oliver Mowse agreeable to a Petition of Capt Israel Moore and Others

11th To see if the Town will Accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with their Treasurer John Maynard

12th To see if the Town Do or Any thing for the Support of Capt John Haynes and his wife for the future agreeable to the Request of Mr Isaac Read or Do or Act any thing Other as the Town shall think Proper when met
