

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally warned May 21st 1770

1st The Town being Meet at Time and Place Proceeded and Chose John Noyes Esq^r a Freeholder and Resident in sd Town to serve for and represent them in a Great and General Court to be Convened, held & kept in Cambridge

Then the Town Proceeded and Chose John Noyes Esq^r Moderator

2^d The Town by their vote Accepted of Lew^t Joseph Willis's Plan of about three acres of Land that he bought of the Towns Com^{tee} which is the land that Philip Bayley once lived on to be to him & his Heirs for ever he giving the Present Town Treasurer security for 6 13 4

3^d This Article was put to vote and Past in the Negative

4th This Article was put to vote and Past in the Affirmation

5th it was put to vote to see if the Town would Chose a Com^{tee} to Propound Mr. Asher Cutler for the support of Capt John Haynes & his wife and it was mentioned to see if the Town would Comply with Capt Wood's offer to take the place that was Mr. Cutler's now in Capt Wood's hands for 62 4 4 and the Town by their vote Chose the selectmen as a Com^{tee} to go and view sd place & mill and make report to the Town at their Next Town Meeting

6th The Town by their vote Chose Mr. Henry Smith Constable
Then the Town Accepted of Ens. Sabel Nuffer to serve Constable in his Room

7th The Town by their vote Appropriated the Sum of Ten Pounds for the Relief of the poore in said Town the present year
Then The Town by their vote Dissolved their meeting
