Nov. 5th 1770 The Town being met at time and place

7th also Granted to pay their Town Treasurer — 2
also Granted to pay their Assessors — 4

8th This article was Put to vote and put in the
Negative

9th it was Put to see if the Town Act upon this
Article and it Pass in the Negative

10th it was Put to vote to see if the Town will Choose
a Com^{tee} to settle with Maj. Josiah Richardsons heirs
Capt Ezekiel How and Mr. Thomas Carr their Damages
by Reason of a County Road Laid out by the Court
Com^{tee} through the New Grants and the Town by their
vote Choose a Com^{tee} viz Lev. Elisha Wheler John Maynard
