These Order you to warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants
off and Belonging to Sudbury in your Ward, Qualified as the
Law Direct to Vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the East Meeting
House in Sudbury on Monday the fourth Day of March Next
at ten o'clock in the fore noon then and there

1st To Choose Select Men, Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Assessors
Constables, and all other Town Officers as the Law Direct Annu-
ally to be chosen in the Month of March

2^d To See if the Town Will Give Liberty for Horses to go at large
without fetters any part of the time from the first of April Next
to the last of September the present year

3^d To See if the Town will by their Vote Give Liberty for Sheep
to go at large in S^d Town any part of the time from the fifteenth
Day of March Next to the first Day of May Next

4th To See if the Town will give liberty for the Swine to go at large
in Said Town the Present year

5th To See if the Town will repair their High Ways by a Rate the
prent Year and Grant a Suitable sum of Money for Repairing
the same and impower the Surveyors to be Collectors of said Rate
Also Order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith

6th To See if the Town will Accept of the Settlement of the Select Men
with the Present Town Treasurer John Maynard

7th To See if the Town by their Vote will Curb the High Way laid out
by the Select Men the last Year Beginning near Micah Goodenows
Dwelling House and from thence laid out by the Head of the Great
Meadow ~~(so called)~~ to West Meadow (so called) by Gates or Bars Agree-
able to a Petition of S^t Daniel Goodenows and others

8th To see if the Town will Choose a Com^{tee} of three Men and impower
them to Settle all the Town Debts, the Week before Debt & Credit
Meeting (Gratis) and lay their Accounts before the Town for their
Acceptance Agreeable to a Petition of Deacon Samuel Parris
and Others

9th To See if the Town will discontinue a Middle Road leading from
Micah Pries to John Lohers, thro the land of John Noyes & Jonas
Lohers Agreeable to a Petition of John Noyes Esq^r and others

10th To See if the Town will Give Liberty to Mr Timothy Underwood and
others, to move the hind Seat in the Mens long Gallery in the East
Meeting House, a little forward and Build a New Seat or Seats at
their own Cost and Charge (provided their appears enough to fill
them) or Do or Act any other way as the Town shall think proper
when met Agreeable to the Request of Timothy Underwood and
Others

11th To See if the Town will Accept of a High Way laid out by the Select
Men in the East thirty Rods High Way so called, at the Request
of Mr Samuel Osborne, Beginning at Lancaster Road so called
and thro the land of Daniel Loring as may more fully appear
by
