Receiving Capt John Haynes and his Wife as inmates into said Town
without giving due Notice as the Law Directs and also for their
Supports, or do or Act any other Way, as the Town shall think
proper when met

3^d To See if the Town will appropriate a suitable sum of Money
out of the Bonds, due to the Town (for land sold by the Towns Order
now in the Treasurers hands), to make an Addition to the Town Stock

4th To See if the Town will appropriate a suitable sum of money
out of the Towns Securities in their Treasurers hands, to new Glaze
their Windows in the Meeting Houses or Repair the old ones, as
the Town shall think proper when met

And make due Return of this Order, with your doings thereon, to
the Select Men, or Town Clerk, at time and place above mentioned

In Obedience to this Order I have warned all the Inhabitants
in my Ward to meet at time and Place according to the Tenor
of this Order Sudbury May 15th 1771

The return of the other three Constables Orders, were as the Law
Directs and Accepted by the Town

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally Warned May 15th 1771
The Town being met at time and place proceeded and chose John Noyes
being a Freeholder and Resident in said Town, to serve for & represent
them in a Great and General Court to be conven'd held and kept
at Harvard College in Cambridge, the ensuing Year.

At 2^d Meeting May 15th 1771 The Town proceeded and chose John
Noyes Esq^r Moderator

2^d Article was put to Vote and passed in the Negative

3^d The Town by their Vote, appropriated the sum of twenty four
pounds thirteen Shillings and four pence & Money out of the
New Grant Bonds to provide a Town Stock of Ammunition

4th The Town by their Vote appropriated the sum of six pounds
& Money out of the Town Securities to Glaze or repair the
Meeting House Windows
