- 3^d To See if the Town will provide a Grammar School Master
and Order where the School shall be kept the year ensuing
and Grant money for the support of the same, ---
- 4th To See if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of the
Reading and Writing School and Order where the School
shall be kept the ensuing year ---
- 5th To See if the Town will Appoint a man or Men to take
Care off and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses insaid Town the
year ensuing, and to dig Graves as their may be Occasion ---
- 6th To See if the Town will Grant money, for the relief of the Poor
in Said Town the present year ---
- 7th To See if the Town will Grant Money to pay their Assessors and
Town Treasurer the present year ---
- 8th To See if the Town will choose a Committee to divide the Town
into Squadrons, where the School shall be kept, and give a
list of the Families to every Quarter, and also to settle the School
in the Southwest Quarter of said Town, Agreeable to the Petition
of John Rice and Others! ---
- 9th To See if the Town will Discontinue that piece of a Town way
between Mr Zechariah Bryants shop and the New Road by
said Bryants Barn, and choose a Committee and impower
and empower them to sell the same, to Doctor Roby or do
or Act any other way as the Town shall think proper when
met, Agreeable to the request of D. Roby ---
- 10th To See if the Town will Build a House to keep the Town Stock
of Powder in and Grant a Sum of Money, for that purpose, and
Order how and where said House shall be Built, and choose a
Committee for that purpose, or do or Act any other way as the
Town shall think proper when met. ---
- 11th To See if the Town will Grant a Suitable sum of Money to
repair their Meeting Houses. ---
- 12th To See if the Town will Grant a Suitable sum of Money to
Widen the Causeway, at Iron work meadows or do or Act as the Town
shall think proper when met. ---
- 13th To See if the Town will Grant Money to repair their
part of the New Bridge Near Deacons Stones ---
