

14th To See if the Town will impower their former Committee or choose a New one to attend on the Courts Committee in their settling the Damages for a Road laid out thro the lands of Cap^t Ezekiel How and Others, or at any other Way, as the Town shall think proper when met

And make due return of this Order with your doings thereon to the Select Men, or Town Clerk at time and place

In Obedience to this Order I have warned all the Inhabitants in my Ward to meet at time and place according to the Tenor of this Order. . . .

The return of the other three Constables Orders were as the Law Directs and accepted by said Town

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally Warned Octob^r 14th 1771 the Town being met at time and place proceeded and chose El^d John Noyes Moderator; then the Town proceeded as follows viz

1st The Town by their Vote appointed a Committee to examine the Town Debts and report at the adjournment

2^d The Town by their Vote Granted to each of their Rev Ministers Twenty four pounds Lawful Money for their Salary the ensuing year provided they live to Supply the Pulpit 148-0-0

3^d The Town Voted to provide a Grammar School Master also voted that the Select Men should provide one, and Voted that the School should be kept as formerly, and Granted thirty pounds for the Support of the same 30-0-0

4th The Town by their Vote Granted twenty pounds for the Reading and Writing School, and Voted it should be kept as it was the past year. 20-0-0

5th The Town by their Vote appointed Benjamin Ball to take care off and sweep the East Meeting House in Sudbury the year ensuing and to dig Graves as there shall be Occasion. Also Isaac Lincoln Jun^r was appointed for the same Service the west side the River

6th The Town by their Vote Granted the sum of twenty five pounds for the Support of the Poor the present year 25-0-0

7th The Town by their Vote Granted Six pounds to pay their Assessors and Town Treasurers, the present year 6-0-0

8th The Town by their Vote chose the Select Men a Committee to divide the Town into Squadrons and Order where the School shall be kept, Agreeable to 1st Article
