- 10th The Town Voted to Build a Powder House, to keep the Town Stock of Ammunition in and chose a Committee viz^t Mr John Balcom Capt Ezekiel How and Mr Elijah Went to consider of the place proper to erect it, and in what manner it shall be Built, and report to the Town at the Adjournment and the Town by their Vote at the adjournment Accepted the report of their Committee, and Granted Seven pounds Nine Shillings and four pence for to erect the same, and agreed with Col. John Noyes to Build it and place it Near or on Wmth Borden's land Near Maj: Curtis. 7 9 4
- 11th The Town by their Vote, Voted to repair their Meeting Houses and Granted Twenty pounds to repair the same 20 - -
- 12th The Town by their Vote Granted Eight pounds to widen the Causeway at Iron Work meadow, and chose a Committee viz^t Ensign Jabez Puffer Mr John Balcom and Lieut Joseph Willis to see the money properly laid out 8 0 -

Then the Town adjourned the Meeting to Monday the 28th Day of Octob^r: Instant at 2 o'Clock P.M. to the same place - The Town being met at time and place, according to the aforesaid Adjournment Proceeded as follows viz^t

- 13th The Town Voted to repair their part of the New Bridge and Granted the sum of five pounds to repair the same - 5 - -
- 14th The Town by their Vote impowered their former Committee viz^t St Elisha Wheeler Mr John Maynard and St Daniel Goodenow to attend on the Court Committee in their settling the Damages for a Road laid out through land, Claimed by Ezekiel How & others
