11th The Town by their Vote Accepted of the Select
mens report with regard to the Standing of
the School Houses the report put on file

12th The Town Voted to Choose a Committee of
three Persons to consider in what manner the
Meeting House on the west Side the River
may be enlarged and chose Es^r Jabez Puffer
Cap^t Ezechiel How & Mr John Maynard for that
purpose they to make report at May Meeting

13th The Town Voted to erect their Powder House
on the training field near Mr Elisha Whelms

14th The Town Voted to provide two Burying
Cloths and to appropriate money to pay for
the same out of the Town Subscription
