These Order you to ^{Warn} all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants off off and belonging to Sudbury (in your Ward) Qualified to Vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the West Meeting House in Sudbury on Monday the twelfth Day of October next at one o' Clock P.M. on said ^{Day} then and there

- 1st To bring in Town Debts and Credit
- 2^d To See if the Town will provide a Grammar School Master and Order where the School shall be kept the year ensuing and grant money for the support of the same
- 3^d To See if the Town will Grant money for the support of a Reading and Writing School and Order where the School shall be kept the ensuing year
- 4th To See if the Town will appoint a Man or Men to take care off and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses in said Town the year ensuing, and to Dig Graves as there may be Occasion
- 5th To See if the Town will Grant money for the Relief of the Poor in said Town the present year
- 6th To See if the Town will Grant Money to pay their Assessors and Town Treasurer the present year
- 7th To See if the Town will Grant the Rev. Mr Josiah Bridge Twenty four pounds for his Salary the ensuing year
- 8th To See if the Town will Grant Mr Jacob Bigelow two ~~thousand~~ two Hundred pounds for his Settlement and Twenty four pounds for his Salary a year, as he has Contracted for, with the West Parish in said Town, and also the improvement of the Ministerial land, belonging to said Parish
- 9th To See if the Town will Chose a Committee and impower them to settle an Action between Sudbury and Framingham, concerning ^{Mr} Dan with a Committee of Framingham chosen for that Purpose
- 10th To See if the Town will Order their Powder House to be removed to
