At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally warned Jan<sup>y</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> 1773  
the Town by their Vote Chose William Baldwin Esq<sup>r</sup> Moderator

Then the Votes and Proceedings of the Townholders and other Inha-  
bitants of the Town of Boston were Read and taken into Consider-  
ation and Debated on, and by a Vote of the Town the following  
Gentlemen viz<sup>t</sup> De<sup>n</sup> Thomas Mympton W<sup>m</sup> Baldwin Esq<sup>r</sup> Cap<sup>t</sup> Elijah  
Smith Maj<sup>r</sup> Joseph Curtis Cap<sup>t</sup> Richard Heard Mr John Fitton &  
and Cap<sup>t</sup> Ezekiel How were chosen a Committee to take the affair  
into Consideration and report what is proper to be done at the  
adjournment of said Meeting &c then the Town by a Vote adjourned  
the meeting to Monday the twenty fifth Day of Jan<sup>y</sup> Instant at two o  
Clock P. M. to meet at the same Place

The Town being met at time and place according to the aforesaid  
Adjournment Proceeded &c

The Committee chosen to consider of the above Affair gave  
in their report to the Town, which after being read and debated  
on, the Vote was put to see if the Town would accept of the report  
and Passed in the Negative

Then the Town by their Vote dismissed the former Committee and  
Chose the following Gentlemen a Committee to report on said Affair  
at the adjournment viz<sup>t</sup> Mr John Maynard Mr John Meriam Mr  
Mr Phineas Gleyzer Mr Jarson Belcher Mr Aaron Haynes Mr W<sup>m</sup>  
Kine Jun<sup>r</sup> & Mr John Balcorn then the Town by their Vote  
adjourned the Meeting to Monday the first Day of Feb<sup>r</sup> Next at  
one o<sup>o</sup> Clock after Noon to meet at the same place

The Town being met at time and place according to the aforesaid
