

- 9th To See if the Town, by their Vote, will Order the Powder House, to be removed to some suitable place, in said Town, and Order the Towns stock of ammunition to be conveyed thereto, or do or act, as the Town shall think proper when met
- 10th To See if the Town will Accept of the List of Jurors, as put into the Box by the Select Men
- 11th To See if the Town will discontinue the Road leading from Doctor Robys to Zechariah Bryants, lying between the two County Road, and choose a Committee to dispose of the same, or do or act, as the Town shall think proper when met
- 12th To See if the Town will ~~accept~~ Discontinue the Town Way from the County Road to Framingham line partly adjoining to Capt. Ezeiel Hows land, and choose a Committee, to dispose of the same, or do or act any other way as the Town shall think proper when met
- 13th To See if the Town will accept of a Road, leading from the County Road to Timothy Emmers, as laid out by the Select Men and Order the same to be Recorded
- And make due Return of this Order with your doings therein to the Select Men or Town Clerk, at time and place above mentioned
