

- 6th To See if the Town will appoint a Man or Men to take Care off and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses, in said Town, the present Year and dig Graves, as there may be Occasion
- 7th To See if the Town will Grant money to pay their Assessors and Town Treasurer the present Year
- 8th To See if the Town will hear the Report of their Committee who were chosen to find out those Persons, who aid and Assist Elijah Moore and others by Purchasing their Effect &c and do or act on the report as the Town shall think proper when met
- 9th To See if the Town will take some more effectual method to prevent Elijah Moore and others from trading with and cheating Strangers, by choosing a Committee to prosecute said Persons as Publick Cheats, or do or act as the Town shall think proper when met

And make due return of this Order with your doings therein to the Select Men, or Town Clerk at time and place above mentioned
