At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally Warned Decem^r 19th 1774 the Town being met at time and place provided and chose Deacon Thomas Plympton Moderator then the Town proceeded and by their Vote accepted of Mr Asher Cutler to serve as Constable in the Room of Mr Silas Goodenow who was chose in March last

These are to Notify and Warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants off and Belonging to Sudbury Qualified as the Law Directs to Vote in Town Affairs and in the choice of Representatives to Meet at the East Meeting House in Sudbury on Monday the Second Day of February Next at two o'Clock After Noon on Do Day then and there

To see if the Town will chose one or more Delegates to Represent them in Provincial Congress on the first Day of Feb^r Next Agreeable to the recommendation of the Provincial Congress as may fully appear by their resolves of the tenth of December 1774

Also to See if the Town will take any Order with respect to their Ministers as recommended by said Congress in their resolves of the tenth of December as a fore said And to do or Act any other matter or thing that shall appear to this Town to be for the publick good when met
