The Town Voted that it was their Minds that after the Minute men
are Select by the Field Officers agreeable to the Recommendation of the
Provincial Congress, that the said Minute men should have a Reasonable
Reward for their Services, as shall be agreed on by this Town at the adjourn-
ment of this Town Meeting

Then the Town by their Vote adjourned their Meeting to Monday the Second
Day of January Next at one of the Clock P.M. at the same place

The Town being met at time and Place according to the aforesaid adjourn-
ment proceed as follows viz^t

the Vote was put to see if the Town would allow their Minute men
one Shilling each Man for every half Day they should Train & March in the
Negative then it was put to see if they would allow them one Shilling &
four pence & paid in the Negative afterward at eight pence per Day and
it passed in the Negative — Then the Town Disposed the Meeting

The Town by their Vote Accepted of this
manner of Warning this Town Meeting

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally Warned Jan^y 30th 1775 at said
meeting the Town proceeded and chose Capt^t Ezekiel How Moderator
then the Town proceeded as follows viz^t

The Town in order to prevent the spreading of the small Pox by Inoculation
or otherways Voted that if those Persons who are Inoculated in the
House lately Capt^t Jonas Noyes should suffer any other Persons to Inter-
