Then the Town by their vote dissolved this Meeting

In Compliance with the Request of the Honorable Provincial Congress in
in their Letter of the 13th of June 1775 to us Directed

These are to Notify and warn all the freeholders and other Inhabitants off and
belonging to Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs
and in the Choise of Representatives. To Meet at the East Meeting House
in Sudbury on Monday the tenth day of July Next ensuing at three
o Clock after Noon Said day then and their

- 1st To Elect and depute one or More Person or Persons being freeholders and
Resident in Said Town to Serve for and Represent Said Town in a Great
and General Court or Assembly to be Convened held and kept for the Service
of this Province at the Meeting House in Watertown on Wednesday the 19th day
of July Next ensuing the date hereof at Nine of the Clock in the
fore Noon and so from day to day during their Session and Sessions
as by the afore Said Letter May more fully appear
- 2^d To See if the Town will accept of Some Suitable person to Serve Constable
in the Room of Cort Samuel How agreeable to his Request
