- 1st To Choose Select Men Town Clerk Town Treas^r Assessors Constables and all other officers as the Law Directs to be Chosen Annually in in the Month of March
 - 2 To See if the Town will Give Liberty for Horses to Go at Large without fetters any part of the year from the first of April Next to the Last Day of September the present year
 - 3 To See if the Town will Give Liberty for Sheep to Go at Large in Town any part of the time from the fifteenth Day of March Next to the last first day of May Next
 - 4 To See if the Town will Give Liberty for the Swine to Go at Large in said Town the present year
 - 5th To See if the Town will Repair their Highways by a Rate the Present year, and Grant a Suitable Sum of Money for Repairing the same and empower the Surveyors to be Collectors of said Rates Also Order the Assessors to Make it into a Rate forthwith
 - 6 To See if the Town will Accept of the Settlement of the Select Men with their present Town Treasurer
 - 7 To See if the Town will Accept of the List of Jurors as put into the Box by the Select Men
 - 8th To See if the Town will Order Seven pounds Sixteen Shillings & two pence Drawn from the Colony Treasury and Now in the Town Treasurers hands, to some Use as the Town shall think proper when Met
 - 9 To See if the Town will Accept of pay for the Powder Balls & flints taken out of the Town Stock for the Use of the Army or Let it Rest till the State of the Colony will permit of Replacing the same
 - 10 To See if the Town will Order their Town Meetings to be warned by Posting up Notifications at Each Meeting House in the Town as the year past
 - 11 To See if the Town will ~~Give to the~~ Choose a Committee of Correspondance Inspection and Safety for the present year Agreeable to the resolve of the General Court of Feb 7th 13 1776
 - 12 To See if the Town will Give to the Soldiers that have Served in the Army the Use of the Armes &c provided for them by the Select Men
 - 13 To See if the Town will Build a New School House in the Southwest Quarter of the Town according to the Petition of ^{Mr} Hopestill Browne and Others
 - 14 To See if the Town will Choose a Committee to provide a School Master for the Southwest Quarter of the Town Agreeable to the petition of ^{Mr} Thomas Walker and others
 - 15 To See if the Town will Accept of a Highway Laid out by the Select Men at the Request of Nathaniel Brown Beginning at the County Road between ^{Mr} John Goodenows and Widow Experience Richardsons Running West over the Brook Called Pinner's wash as may more fully appear by the Minutes of said ways
