

- 8th To See if the Town will appoint a man or men to take Care of and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses in Said Town and to Dig Graves as as there may be occasion
- 9th To See if the Town will Grant money to pay the Assessors and Town Treasurer the present year
- 10th To See if the Town will Choose some Suitable person to take the Acknowledgment and Recognizance of Debts according to an act of the General Court Intituled an Act providing a Speedy and Cheap Course for the Recovery of Debts
- 11th To See if the Town will Grant a Suitable Sum of money (or appropriate part of the money in the Town Treasurer's hands) to purchase a Book for Entering Recognizances of Debts according to the act aforesaid

This Notification has been posted up at each Meeting House in Sudbury according to the vote of the Town at their Annual meeting in March last by order of the Select men James Thompson Town Clerk

The Town by their vote accepted of the warning of this Meeting

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally Warned October 14th 1776 The Town being met at time and place proceeded and chose Col^l Eschiel How Moderator; Then the Town proceeded to the work of the Day set forth in the warrant; and after a long debate on the second article the vote was put up Whether the Town would give their consent that the General Court of this State should compose a form of Government, agreeable to the resolve of the House of Representatives on the 17th of September 1776 And it passed in the Negative

Then the Town by their vote adjourned this Meeting to Monday the fourth Day of Nov^r Next at one of the clock in the after noon to meet at the same place

The Town being met at time and place according to the aforesaid Adjournment proceeded to the third article and allowed the following Debts viz
