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- These are to Notify and Warn all the freeholders and other Inhabitants of and belonging to Sudbury Qualified as the Law Directs to vote in Town Affairs to Meet at the East Meeting House in Sudbury on Monday the third Day of March Next Ensuing, at ten of the Clock before Noon, on 3^d Day then and there first to Choose a Moderator
- 2^d To Choose Selectmen Town Clerk Town Treasurer Assessors Constables and all other Town officers as the Law directs Annually to be Chosen in the Month of March
 - 3^d To See if the Town will Give Liberty for Horses to go at Large without fetters any part of the year from the first of April Next to the Last Day of September the present year
 - 4^d To See if the Town will Give Liberty for Sheep to go at Large in Said Town any part of the Time from the fifteenth Day of March Next to the first Day of May Next
 - 5^d To See if the Town will Give Liberty for the Swine to go at Large in Town the present year
 - 6th To See if the Town will Repair their Highway by a Rate the present year and Grant a Sutable Sum of Money for Repairing the Same, and Impower the Surveyors to be Collectors of 3^d Rates, Also order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith
 - 7^d To See if the Town will accept of the Selectmen Settlement of the Selectmen with their present Treasurer
 - 8th To See if the Town will accept of the List of Furors as put into the Box by the Selectmen
 - 9th To See if the Town will Repair the School House near to Mr Isaac Haynes', or Build a New School House. According to the petition of Mr Josiah Brown and others
 - 10th To See if the Town will Choose a Committee to Examine what Each man in Sudbury has Done as to Actual Service or by hiring men in the present war, and take Some Measure to Make the Burthen Equil, and adopt Some Measure to Encourage the Raising the present army, according to the petition of Mr John Meriam and others, or do or act as the Town Shall think proper when Met
 - 11th To See if the Town will Grant a Sufficient Sum of Money to pay the Soldiers that voluntarily enlisted for Canada Last July, agreeable to the vote of the Town at their Meeting on the fifteenth Day of July Last. According to the Desire of Capt Daniel Bowker and others
 - 12th To See if the Town will Discontinue a Road Laid out through the Inclosure of En Josiah Richardson at the Request of Nathaniel Brown from being an open way, and leave it a Bridle way
