

* Also voted that the Grant of Twenty Pounds per man to be paid to Each ~~to~~ that shall enlist into the Continental army shall be paid to Such only as shall enlist before the twenty-fourth Day of March instant

Then the Town adjourned their Meeting to Monday the Twenty-fourth Day of March instant at one of the Clock after Noon at the Same place

Monday ~~March~~ 24th The Town being Met at time and place according to the aforesaid Adjournment the Question was put whether the Town would act upon the seventh 7th article and it passed in the Negative

11th article passed in the Negative

13th voted that Said Committee should prosecute Said action forthwith voted to Continue the 20 pound Bounty to be paid to the Soldiers ~~to~~ untill the 7th Day of April Next

Then the Town by their vote Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the Seventh Day of April Next at two of the Clock after Noon at the Same place

Monday April 7th The Town being Met at Time and place according to the aforesaid Adjournment. The Committee Chosen to Estimate the Services Done by Each person in Sudbury in the present war Reported and the Town Accepted of their Report Excepting the Commission Officers

This vote was afterward Reconsidered and the Town voted to Recommit the Report and Said Committee to Report at May meeting. Also voted to Defer the Militia officers to Call their Companies together in order to forward the enlisting the men for the Continental army

Then the Town adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 21st Day of April instant at three of the Clock after Noon at the Same place

* Monday April 21st The Town being Met at time and place according to the aforesaid adjournment proceeded and Granted the Sum of twelve Hundred Pounds for to pay Sixty men that shall or may enlist as this Towns Quota of the fifteen Battalions to be raised in this State Twenty Pounds Each and Ordered the assessors ~~and~~ to make Said Sum into a Rate forth with and also ordered that the Said Sum of Money shall be paid into the Town Treasury by the first Day of June Next *

Then the Town Reconsidered their vote for putting off the Report of the Committee to Estimate the Services in the present war to May Meeting and Said Committee Reported as follows viz^t

Y The Committee appointed in March 1777 to Estimate the Services performed by the Several Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury in the present war with Great Britain whether personal or by hiring, in order that the further occasioned by the war may be made more Equiv Report as follows viz^t

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That every person have Credit for the Sum or Sums of Money by him paid for the purpose of hiring men into the Service at any time since the Commencement of the present war, when a certain number of men were Levied upon the Town.
