 those belonging to Co^t Greeton and went into Canada) be

 That the two Months men at Cambridge in Feb^y & March 1776
 did not enlist into the Continental Regiments be allowed each - 1:4:0
 That the men which went to Ficonderoga be allowed each - - 8:0:0
 That the two months men that went to New York be allowed each - 4:0:0
 That the three months Men at New York be allowed each - - - 6:0:0
 That the Men which went with Capt Moulton to Dochester be allowed
 Each for three Months - - - - - 1 16 0

That the Men at Boston and places adjacent be allowed each - 0 16 0
 But that no person shall receive any benefit from any of the above allow-
 -ances but such as shall be taxed towards the payment thereof however he
 might otherwise have been exempted. Likewise no person having been hired
 to performe any of the Services above mentioned, shall be intitled to any
 allowance for that particular Service, or any other preceding Service, except
 he choose to Give Credit for the Sum or Sums so received, then to have
 Allowance as tho^o no such Money had been received.

Also that every person claiming any of the foregoing allowances, shall be con-
 sidered as having been in the Service the whole time to which that per-
 -ticular allowance ~~was made~~ is annexed, except he was regularly Discharged,
 and shall receive in proportion to the Time he was in the Service

This report was accepted by the Town. also voted that the Melitia officers
