

2^d To Choose by Ballot Some person firmly Attached to the American Cause to procure and lay before the Court the Evidence that may be had of the inimical Dispositions toward this or any of the united States of any inhabitants of this Town agreeable to an Act of the General Court of this State passed the present year

3^d To Choose three five or seven persons to be under oath to prosecute all Breaches of the Acts to prevent Monopoly and Oppression that shall Com to their knowledge as directed in said acts

4th To allow to the Several persons that have been in the Service of this Contenant or of this State or have Advanced Money toward hiring men into the Service in the present war the Sums affixed to their particular Services. By the report of a Committee Chosen Last March meeting and order the Assessors to make the Same into a Rate forthwith or do or act any other way Relative to Equilizing the Burthen of the present war as the Town shall think proper when met

5th To hear the Report of a Committee Chosen Last March meeting to view the School House near to Mr Israel Haynes, and Choose a Committee to Build or Repair said School House

6th To See if the Town will petition the General Court for a new hearing Relating to a Road Laid out through the inclosures of East Josiah Richardson

Make due Return of this order with your doings thereon to the Select men or Town Clerk at time and place above mentioned

Sudbury June 16th 1777

Sudbury June 20th 1777 I have warned or caused to be warned all Qualified to act in Town affairs in my ward to meet at time and place as within Directed Josiah Richardson Constable

The Returns of the other three Constables were Similar to this and were accepted by the Town

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally warned June 23rd 1777 The Town being met at time and place according to the above warning proceeded and Chose Col^l Ezekiel How Moderator

2^d Chose Maj^r Jonathan Parmonter for the purpose Expressed in this article

3^d Chose Mr John Maynard Maj^r Jonathan Parmonter Cap^t Sam^l Knight Cap^t Nath^l Maynard and Mr Phineas Puffer for the purpose Expressed in this article

4th There were Several votes passed on this article but were afterward Reconsidered as Recorded hereafter

5th The Committee referred to in this article Reported to Repair said School House and the Town accepted of their Report

Then the Town adjourned their Meeting to Monday the 30th Day of June instant at two of the Clock after noon at the Same place

June 30th The Town being met at time and place according to the above Adjournment and the Moderator being absent Thomas Plympton Esq^r was Chosen Moderator. P. P. Then the Town proceeded to the fifth article
