

X 5th The Committee Referred to in this Article Reported to Repair Said School House and the Town Accepted of their Report and Chose the following persons a Committee to Repair the Same viz m^r Ambrose Tower Deaⁿ Samuel Dakin and m^r Isaac Puffer

6th The Town Voted to Petition to the General Court for a Rehearing Relating to the Road Laid out through the inclosures of En^r Josiah Richardson also Directed the Select men of Said Town to forward a petition to the General Court in the Name of the Town

Then the Town by their vote Adjourned their meeting to Monday the 7th Day of July Next at two of the Clock after noon at the Same place
July the 7th The Town being met at time and place according to the above Adjournment proceeded to take under Consideration the fourth article and after a long Debate the Town by their vote Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 14th Day of July Instant at one of the Clock after noon at the Same place

July 14th The Town being met at time and place according to the above Adjournment Several votes was passed on the 4th article in the order for the meeting which was afterward Reconsidered Then the Town by their vote Adjourned this Meeting to Friday the 25th Day of July instant at three of the Clock after noon at the Same place

Friday July 25th The Town being met at time and place according to the above Adjournment, and the Moderator being absent they Chose Capt Richard Heard Moderator P. T. and by their vote Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 6th Day of October Next at one of the Clock after noon at the Same place

October 6th The Town being met at time and place according to the above Adjournment and the Moderator being absent Capt Richard Heard was Chosen Moderator Then the Town by their vote Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 29th day of December Next at one o^o Clock after noon at the Same place

December 29 The Town being met according to Adjournment after Choosing a Committee Relating to the fourth article They Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 5th day of January Next at three o^o Clock after noon at the East Meeting House in Sudbury

January 5th The Town being met at time and place according to adjournment proceeded to and by their vote Reconsidered all votes that had passed on the fourth article, and Chose the following persons a Committee to bring to the Town at a future Meeting an account of the Services of each person ~~in~~ belonging to Sudbury in the present war, and the Sumes that they shall receive for the Same viz m^r William Rice for m^r John Meriam Capt Moses Stone Lt Phineas Glazen & Capt Jonathan Rice

Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this Meeting
