

- 1st To Choose a moderator and bring in Town Debts and Credit - - -
- 2^d To See if the Town will Grant to their Rev^d ministers their Salaries for the year Ensuing: and if they will add a suitable Sum thereto for their maintenance for the Ensuing year
- 3^d To See if the Town will Grant money for the Support of the Grammar School, and order where Said School shall be kept the ensuing year
- 4th To See if the Town will Grant money for the Support of a Reading, and writing School: and Order where Said School shall be kept the ensuing year
- 5th To See if the Town will Grant money for the Relief of the Poor in in Said Town the Ensuing year
- 6th To See if the Town will appoint a man, or men, to take care of and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses, in Said Town, the Ensuing year, and to Dig Graves, as there may be occasion
- 7th To See if the Town will Grant money to pay their Assessors and Town Treasurer the present year.
- 8th To See if the Town will Choose a Committee to provide for the families of the Continental Soldiers belonging to this Town: Agreeable to a Resolve of the General Court of this State; Dated Sept^r 29th 1777
