1 To Chose a Moderator and to See if the Town will Grant Money to provide Clothing
for their Quota of men in the Continental Army, according to a Resolve of the
General Court Dated March 13th 1778 or do or act Relating to providing Said
Clothing as the Town shall think proper when met

2 To See if the Town will Do or act any thing further Relating to hiring the Remains
of this Towns Quota of the Continental Army.

And Make due Return of this Order with your Doings thereon to the Select men or Town
Clerk at time and place above mentioned

by the Town

At a Legal Town Meeting in Sudbury west meeting House March 30th 1778

The Town being met at time and place according to the foregoing warning proceeded and Chose m^r
John Maynard Moderator. Then the Town Adjourned this Meeting to Wednesday the first Day of
April next at four o^{clock} after noon at the same place

Wednesday April 1st The Town being met at time and place according to the above Adjournment
proceeded and Voted to raise money to purchis Said Clothing ^{granted} and the Sum of Three Hundred &
Seventy five pounds, to purchis 77 Shirts 77 Pairs of Shoes and 77 Pair of Stockings, to
be provided by the Select men and Committee of Said Town, agreeable to the Resolve of the
General Court referred to in this article. And Ordered the Assessors to make Said Sum into a
Rate forth with

2 Chose two men in addition to the Committee Chosen Last town Meeting to hire Eighteen
men to make up this Towns Quota in the Continental Army viz^t L^t John Noyes and Capt
Nath^l Maynard

Then the Town Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 13th Day of April instant at four o^{clock}
after noon at the same place

Monday April 13th The Town being met at time and place according to the above Adjournment
Voted that if the Committee Chosen to hire the men to make up this Towns Quota in the Conti-
nental Army cannot hire them for 74 Lach, they are impowered to Give them more and
and to Lay their accounts before the Town for allowance

Then the Town Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 27th Day of April instant at four o^{clock}
after noon at the same place

Monday April 27th The Town being met at time and place according to the above Adjourn-
ment proceeded to Dissolve this Meeting
