- 1st To Choose a Moderator and hear the Report of their Committee Chosen at their
meeting on the Sixth Day of May Last to hier the men Levied on this Town in
Consequence of the Resolves of the General Court Dated the 20th of April 1778
and allow the accounts of said Committee, and Grant Money to Discharge the
Same, and Order the Assessors to Make it into a Rate forthwith. or act
Relating to this article as the Town shall think proper when met.
 - 2^d To See if the Town will Grant Money to hier the men to Go to the North River
for Eight months agreeable to the before mentioned Resolves of the General Court
or Do or act as the Town shall think proper when met.

And make Due Return of this Order with your Doings thereon to the Selectmen
or Town Clerk at time and place above mentioned

The Returns of the other Constables were according to Law and accepted by the town

At a Legall Town Meeting in Sudbury June 4th 1778

The Town being met at time and place aforesaid and Chose Col Ezekiel How Moderator
then the Town by their vote passed over to the Second article and Chose the former Com-
mittee that was Chosen to hier the men for nine Months viz^t Capt Jon^a Rice L^t Joseph
Goodenow L^t Rowand Bogle Capt Asahel Wheeler L^t Joshua Haynes L^t Abijah Brigham
Maj^r Jon^a Parmenter Lt Jon^a Hoar Capt Isaac Cutting M^r John Meriam L^t Rice
with the addition of the following Gentlemen viz^t M^r Thos^s Glyzen Col Ezekiel
How Capt Nath^l Maynard Serj^t Asher Cutler Serj^t Hopestill Willis. to hier
twelve men to Go to the North River for Eight Months, on such terms as
they will Engage for, and to Lay their accounts before the Town at the Adjournment
of this Meeting for payment

Then the Town took the first article under Consideration and Granted the Sum of one
Thousand Seven Hundred and twenty five Pounds to pay fourteen men that
have ben Hired by the Town's Committee for that purpose to Reinforce the Continen-
tal army for nine Months. And Ordered the assessors to make it into a Rate forth-
with

Then the Town by their vote Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 15th Day of June instant
at four o^{clock} after noon at the same place

Monday June 15th The Town being met at time and place according to Adjournment
proceeded and voted to Grant the Sum of One Thousand and one Hundred Pounds
for a Bounty for twelve men to Go to the North River agreeable to the before
mentioned Resolves. And Ordered the Assessors to Make it into a Rate forthwith
Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this Meeting
