town affairs to meet at the East Meeting House in Sudbury on Thursday
the 25th Day of June Instant at two o^c clock after noon. on said Day then & there

1st To Choose a Moderator. And see if the ^{Town will} make proper allowances to Each Person that
has Done Services in the present war either in person or by hiring, and Grant money
to pay the same. And Order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith, or do
or act as the Town shall think proper when met, agreeable to the Petition of
Col Ezekiel How and others M^r James Mosman L^t Joshua Haynes & others

2nd To See if the Town will vote to Divide the town of Sudbury and make it
two towns, and take the necessary Steps therefor or act on this article as
the Town shall think proper when met according to the Petition of M^r
John Tilton and others

3rd To See if the Town will Order the Committee that was appointed to Repair
the School House near to M^r Phineas Puffers, to Build a New School
House on the same place where the Old House stands, and appropriate
the Old house to the use of Rebuilding or do or act as the Town shall think
proper when met agreeable to the Petition of M^r James Mosman and
others

4th To Choose a Suitable person for an Assessor in the Room of Cap^t Caleb Moulton
who is Engaged in the publick Service

5th To See if the Town will Order that their town meetings shall be warned
for the future or untill further Order from the Town, by posting up notify-
cations at each Meeting House, or other publick places in the Town

6th To See if the Town will Grant money to hier the men that are to be
Detached from the Militia of this Town in consequence of a Resolve of the
General Court Dated June 10th 1778 or act on this article as the Town shall
think proper when met

And make due Returne of this Order with your Doing thereon to the Select-
men or Town Clerk at time and place above mentioned

voted that all that have paid fines, shall be Considered as having Done
Services in the war and to have proper allowances therefor. Also
voted to Choose Seven Men a Committee. To produce to the Town an account
of the Services of Each person in Sudbury in the present war and the names
of money that they shall receive therefor. viz^t Col Ezekiel How M^r
