- 2^d The Question was put whether it was the minds of the Town that the Town of Sudbury should be divided into two towns and it passed in the affirmative. And appointed the following Gentlemen to agree on a Division Line and Report at the Adjournment of this meeting viz^t Col Ezekiel How Capt^t Richard Hoard M^r Nathan Loving M^r Phineas Glezen M^r John Maynard and M^r John Meriam
- 3^d voted to Rebuild said School house according to the Request of the Petition
- 4th Chose W^m Baldwin Esq^r Assessor in the Room of Capt^t Molton
- 5th voted to warn Town Meetings untill further order from the Town by posting up notifications at each Meeting House in the town
- 6th voted to appoint the three Commissioned officers and all the Serjants of each Militia Company in Sudbury a Committee to hire fifteen men Required of this Town in consequence of the Resolve of the General Court referred to in this article. Also voted that said Committee shall agree with the 15 men on the best terms they can, and the Town shall be held to fulfill their Contracts

Then the Town by their vote Adjourned this meeting to Monday the Sixth Day of July Next at four o' Clock after noon at the same place

Monday July 6th The Town being Met at time and place proceeded to hear the Report of the Committee appointed to agree on a Division Line in the town who Reported that they could not agree

Then the Town voted to Reconsider the vote for Dividing the Town of Sudbury

- 6th Then the Town took up the Sixth article again and Granted the Sum of Six Hundred and forty four pounds, to hire fourteen men for the Service at Providence in the Room of the fifteen before mentioned and Ordered the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith

Then the Town by their vote Ordered their Committee appointed to Estimate the Services of each particular person in Sudbury in the present war to Report at the Next Town Meeting, which they promised to Do

Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this Meeting
