

These are to notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of and belonging to Sudbury (Qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the West Meeting House in Sudbury on Monday the Nineteenth Day of October instant, at one of the Clock after noon. on 3^d Day

- 1st To Chose a Moderator and to bring in Town Debts and Credit
- 2^d To See if the Town will Grant to their Rev^d Ministers their Salaries, and if they will make a Resonable addition thereto for the Ensuing year
- 3^d To See if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of a Grammar School and Order where Said School Shall be kept the Ensuing year
- 4th To See if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of a Reading and writing School and Order where Said School Shall be kept the Ensuing year
- 5th To See if the Town will Grant money for the Relief of the Poor in Said Town the present year
- 6th To See if the Town will appoint a man or men to take Care of and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses in Sudbury and to Digge Graves as there may be occasion the present year
- 7th To See if the Town will Grant Money to pay the Assessors and Town Treasurer the present year
- 8th To hear the Report of their Committee appointed to Estimate the Services of each particular person in Sudbury in the present war from the nineteenth of April 1775 to this present time, and Grant Money to pay the Same, and Order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith
- 9th To See if the Town will Choose a Committee and fully impowre them to settle the Dispute in Law that has arisen between this Town and the Town of Marlboro^{re} relating to the maintainance of Mr Mary Knight or act any other way as the Town Shall think proper when met
- 10th To Choose a Suitable person for an Assessor in the Room of L^t Matthias Mosman who is Engaged in the publick Service
- 11th To See if the Town will make up to Capt Daniel Bowker the Loss of a Thirty Dollar Bill which he took of Mr Jason Bent for Rales in the year 1776 which Bill is a Counterfit
- 12th To See if the Town will Choose a Committee to take Care of S^r Jonathan Maynards Estate. and to prosecute any persons that have trespassed thereon
- 13th To See if the Town will Grant Money to pay the intrest of the Money that their Committee have Borrowed to hire Soldiers into the Service and order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith
