Then the Town Voted that the Town be Divided by the River Running thro^t the Same and the Island called Pulhams Farme, now the property of Capt Richard Heard and his Sons, be Annexed to the East Side of the River, the Land on the East Side of said River to be set off from the Town of Sudbury

Then the Town Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the fifteenth Day of Feb^y instant at one of the Clock after noon at the same place, to Consider further on the first article

Monday Feb^y 15th The Town being met according to the above Adjournment, and after a long Debate on the first Article, the Question was put wheter the Town would add any more to the East Side of the River, and it passed in the Negative then the Town by their vote Dissolved this meeting

These are to notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of and Belonging to Sudbury qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs to meet at the East Meeting-House in Sudbury on Monday the 29th Day of March Currant, at one o^c Clock after noon, on said Day then and there

- 1st To Chose a Moderator, and any Town officers Required by Law to be Chosen Annually in the Month of March
- 2^d To see if the Town will Give liberty for Swine to go at large in said Town the present year
- 3^d To see if the Town will Repair their High ways by a Rate the present year and Grant a Suitable Sum of money for Repairing the same, and Order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith, and empower the Surveyors to be Collectors of said Rates
- 4th To see if the Town will accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with their present Treasurer James Thompson
- 5th To hear the Report of their Committee appointed and empowered to settle the Dispute in Law between this Town and the Town of Marlborough Relating to the Maintainance of Mary Knight, And appropriate the money that they have Received of the Town of Marlboro^{gh} to some use as the Town shall think proper when met
- 6th To see if the Town will Build a New School House in the Southwest Quarter of the Town, at a centre agreed upon by said Quarter, or about ten Rods from said centre, and appropriate the old School House on the Great Road to the use of building a New one. According to the petition of m^r Silas Moore and Others
- 7th To see if the Town will Sell Col: Ezekiel How and En^s Josiah Richardson Lancaster old Road or Highway that m^r Benjamin Wrights Grant was bounded on and vote an acquittance, and Order the same to be Recorded, do or act on said affair as the Town shall think proper when met
- 8th To see if the Town will Discontinue a Town Road Laid out through the inclosures of En^s Josiah Richardson, over the Mill Brook or winners wash, from being a open way, and leave it a Bridle way as formerly, or act on said affair as the Town shall think proper when met According to the Desier of said Richardson
