

9th To see if the Town will sell to M^r John Brigham a piece of Land part of the East Thirty Rod Highway, said piece of Land lies on the North Side of the Road leading from S^r Joseph Willis to Sudbury west meeting House as may appear by the plan of said Land according to the Request of S^r John Brigham

10 To hear the Report of their Committee, appointed at the Last Town Meeting to agree on a Line for Dividing the Town of Sudbury, and transact any Matter or thing Relative to the Division of said Town

11th To see if the Town will Choose a Committee to provide necessaries for the families of the Noncommissioned officers, and private Soldiers, belonging to this Town enlisted for three years or During the war, according to the Resolves of the General Court Dated Feb^y 4th 1779 and Oct^r. 10 1777 and Grant a suitable Sum of money for providing said necessaries, and Order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith
