

- 2^d Voted that Swine May go at Large in Said Town the present Year
- 3^d Voted to Repair their Highways by a Rate the present Year, and granted the sum of Four Hundred pounds for Repairing the same and Voted that the wages be ^{for Highway work} four times so much by the Day as has been usually allowed and ordered the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith and
- 10th Then the Town passed over to the tenth article, and the Committee informed the Town that they were not agreed, then the Question was put whether the Town would act on this article, and it passed in the negative
- 4th The Town accepted of the Selectmen with their Treasurer James Thompson, which was as is hereafter Recorded
- 5th The Committee ~~the~~ ^{for} informed the Town that they had come to an agreement with the Committee of the Town of Marlborough ^{relating} which was as follows Whereas a Controversy has subsisted between the Town of Sudbury and the Town of Marlborough relating to the Maintenance of Mary Knight a pauper. We the Subscribers being chosen agreeable to a vote of said Town of Marlboro^{re} Legally assembled on 17th Octo 1778 to make a settlement ^{ment} of we thought proper, with the Town of Sudbury respecting the said Knight
- Do hereby and in behalf of the Town of Marlborough, agree to take the said Mary on Monday next, so that the Town of Sudbury be indemnified from any charge respecting the Support of the said Mary Knight in future also paying to the Committee of Sudbury the sum of Twenty Pounds

- 6th Voted to Build a New School House in the Southwest Quarter of the Town this vote was afterward reconsidered
- 7th Chose M^r John Maynard Cap^t Jon^s Rice and m^r Tho^s Walker a Committee to agree with Col How and En^d Richardson respecting said Land, and Report at a future Town Meeting
- 8th The Question was put whether the Town would Discontinue the way mentioned in this article and it passed in the negative
- 9th Voted to appoint the Committee that is appointed to agree with Col How & En^d Richardson, to view the Land and with said Brigham, and Report at a future Town Meeting
- 11th Chose the Committee of Correspondance and Lt Jacob Read and Lt Oliver Hayes a Committee to provide Necessaries for the families of the Contin^{tal} Soldiers belonging to this Town, and Granted the sum of two Hundred pounds to purchase said Necessaries, and Ordered the Assessors to Make said sum into a Rate forthwith
- Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this Meeting
