

This Notification has been posted up at Each meeting House in Sudbury according to the
Vote of Said Town By Order of the Selectmen James Thompson Town Clerk
The Town by their vote accepted of the warning of this meeting

1st At a Legall Town Meeting in Sudbury May 17 1779 The Town being met
at time and place according to the foregoing warning proceeded and Chose
Capt Jonathan Rice being a Freeholder and Resident in this Town to serve
for and Represent them in a Grate and General Court to be Convened Held and kept at
the State House in Boston on Wednesday the 26 Day of May instant according to the
Precept sent to Said Town

2^d Then the Town Chose Capt Jonathan Rice Moderator, and proceeded as follows the Ques-
tion was put whether the Town Thought it Expedient to at this time to have a new
Constitution or forme of Government made, and on a Devision it appeared that there
was of the persons voting at Said Meeting fifty Nine in the affirmative and ten
in the Negative. Also voted to instruct their Representative to vote for Calling
a State Convention for the purpose of forming a new Constitution

7th Then the Town passed over to the Seventh article and appointed the Militia
officers a Committee to hire the men to be Detached from the Militia of this Town
By Order of Council to March to Fivertown. and also Granted the Sum of one
Thousand and three Hundred Pound to hire Said men, and in addition to the sum
of two Hundred Pounds Granted at Last March Meeting to provide Necessaries for
the families of the Continental Soldiers belonging to this Town, as Expressed in the
fifth article & voted to Order the Assessors to make Said sum into a Rate forthwith

3^d Then the third article Came under Consideration and the Town allowed the following
accompts viz to the Selectmen for providing for the families of the Continental
Soldiers since Last October

viz To Thos Walker for necessaries provided for Uriah Moore's wife . 39 15 10
To Tho^s Damon jun^r for providing for Phinehas Butler's wife . 66 9 0
To L^t Josiah Farrar for providing for Simon c^t Newton's family . 76 4 3
To Cap^t Asahel Wheeler for providing for Benjⁿ Tower's family . 59 16 6
To Cap^t Moses Stone for Noah Bailey & Roland Bennet's families . 67 12 6
To Cap^t Richard. Heard for articles Delivered to Rowland Bennet's wife . 3 14 0

4th The Town Chose W^m Baldwin Esq^r M^r John Maynard Cap^t Caleb Moutton
and Cap^t Joseph Smith in addition to the Committee Chosen to provide for the
families of the Continental Soldiers belonging to this Town

5th The Town by their vote impowered the Committee Chosen for the purpose aforesaid
to Draw the Money out of the Treasury for to purchis necessaries for the families
of the Continental Soldiers belonging to this Town

6th Voted to Build a New School House in the Southwest Quarter of the Town
Appropriating the two Old School Houses to the use of Building the New one
and Chose Col. Ezekiel How Cap^t Sam^l Kwright and Cap^t Israel Moore to a
Committee to Build or Cause the same to be Built.

Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this meeting
