At a Legal Town Meeting in Sudbury June 21 1779

The Town being met at time and place according to the foregoing warning
proceeded and Chose Cap^t Jon^s Rice Moderator Then the Town proceeded as follows
viz¹ 1st Voted to hire the men ~~required~~ to be Drafted Detached or enlisted from the
Militia of this Town in Consequence of the Resolves of the Great and General
Court passed June 8th and 9th 1779 and to Grant Money to hire 20 men
Also by their votes appointed the ~~Militia~~ ^{Commissary} Officers of each of the Militia Companies
in Town a Committee to hire Thirteen to reinforce the Continental army for
¹²⁵ nine months and five men to be Detached from this Town for the Service at Rhode
Island agreeable to above mentioned Resolves

Then the Town adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 28th Day of June instant at
two o' Clock after noon at the same place
