

3 article The Town by their votes appointed the following Gentlemen to be a Standing Committee, to hire men for the Publick Service in behalf of the Town when ever there may be a Call on the Militia for Soldiers viz Capt Asahel Wheeler Lt Joshua Haynes Lt Abijah Brigham Capt Jon^s Rice Lt Joseph Goodenow Lt Rowan Bogle Capt John Boyes Lt Jon^s Hoar Lt Tho^s Brintnal Jun^r Capt Robert Cutting Lt Wm Hunt and Lt Isaac Rice Jun^r

4th The fourth article was not acted upon.

5 voted to allow Capt Jesse Emes thirty two pounds ten shillings, on Condition that he ~~the~~ ^{bring} a Certificate from Ezra Taylor Esq^r Signifying that he the sd Emes is to have the benefit of what the sd Taylor has Done in the present war by paying money to hire Soldiers, and that the Town of Sudbury is Discharged from any Demand from him on that account

Then the Town took up the first article and Granted the Sum of 3900 [£] to hire 18 men into the Service for Nine Months agreeable to the Resolve Refered in this article

Then the Town Granted the Sum of four Hundred and Twenty Pound^s 420 to hire 5 men to be Detached from the Militia, of this Town in consequence of a Resolve of the General Court Refered to in the Second article and to pay the Interest of the Money that is to be Borrowed by the Committee to hire the men for the Services aforesaid, and also voted to Impower Said Committee to ^{give} Borrow the money Granted for the purposes aforesaid and Give Security on interest in behalf of the Town for the Same

6th voted to Order the assessors to make all the Money Granted by the Town at this Meeting (Except what was Granted to Capt Emes) into a Rate forthwith

Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this Meeting

These are to notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of and belonging to Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs and all other male Inhabitants of sd Town, Being Twenty one years of age and free to meet at the next meeting House in Sudbury on Monday the Twelfth Day of July instant at Three of the Clock afternoon in sd Day then and there

1st To Choose a Moderator: and see if the Town will Elect one or more Delegates to Represent them in a Convention to meet at Cambridge in the County of Middlesex on the first Day of September next, for the sole purpose of framing a new Constitution or form of Government. And if they will instruct their Delegate or Delegates so Chosen to Cause a printed Copy of the form of a Constitution they May agree upon in Convention, to be transmitted to the Selectmen of this Town, Agreeable to the Recommendation of the Great and General Court of this State Dated June 15th 1779

2 To take under Consideration the proceedings of the Inhabitants of the Town of Boston Merchants and others Concerned in Trade, together with a Circular Letter from the Committee of Correspondence Inspection, and Safety of the Town of Boston to the Committee of Correspondence &c of Sudbury Relating to the Depreciation of our Currency and act Relative thereto as the Town shall think proper when met

3 To see if the Town will Grant a Sum of money, and Order the assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith, for the purpose of hiring Soldiers into the Publick Service when ever there may be occasion therefor: and Impower their Committees already Chosen for that purpose, to agree with men to serve as Soldiers in behalf of this Town on the best terms they Can, whenever there shall be a Call for men, or do or act on
