

- 3^d To see if the Town will Choose a Committee to take Special Care that the Resolutions of the Convention at Concord and such other Regulations as may be Com into by this Town Recommended by Said Convention be fully Complied with by Individualls
- 4th To see if the Town will Choose a Delegate or Delegates to ~~Represent them in a~~ Meet at Concord on the first Wednesday of October next: to Take into Consideration the Prices of Merchandice and Country produce, and ^{to} make such Regulations and reductions as the Publick Good may Require
- 5th To see if the Town will Elect one or more Delegates to Represent them in a Convention, to Meet at Cambridge in the County of Middlesex on the first Day of September next, for the sole purpose of Framing a New Constitution or forme of Government: And if they will instruct their Representative or Representatives so Chosen, to Cause a printed Copy of the form of a Constitution they may agree upon in Convention, to be transmitted to the Selectmen of this Town Agreeable to the Recommendation of the Great and General Court of this State Dated June 15 1779

At a Legall Town Meeting in Sudbury August 9 1779

- The Town being met at time and place according to the foregoing warning, proceeded and Chose Capt Jon^s Rice Moderator, and took up the first article, and Voted that this Town do approve of the Resolves of the Convention at Concord Relating to the prices of the Necessaries of Life
- 1st Chose a Committee of Seven persons to State the prices of all such articles as were not taken up by the Convention at Concord viz Col. Ezekeel How m^r Tho^s Walker W^m Baldwin Esq^r Capt Asahel Wheeler M^r Phineas Glezon M^r John Meriam and M^r Sam^l Puffer, to Report at the Adjournment of this meeting
 - 2^d Chose the Committee of Correspondence, with the addition of the following persons viz Capt Aaron Haynes Lt Josiah Farrar M^r Phineas Glezon Lt Matthias Mosman and Lt Nath^l Reeves a Committee to take Special Care that the Resolves of the Convention at Concord, and such other Regulations as may be Com into by this Town, are fully Complied with by Individualls
 - 3th Chose William Baldwin Esq^r and M^r Samuel Puffer for the Purpose Expressed in this article
 - 4th Chose Col^l Ezekeel How a Delegate to meet in Convention at Cambridge on the first Day of September next for the sole purpose of Framing a New Constitution

Then the Town by their vote Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 16th Day of August Instant at four o^{clock} afternoon at the same place
