

Meeting to Monday the 22 Day of May instant at one of the Clock afternoon, at the same place

1st Monday May 22 The Town being met at time and place according to the foregoing Adjournment they and the Constitution being Read and Considered by Single Paragraphs the hereafter named Desired the following alterations or Amendments Made therein viz They think it is Reasonable that Each Town in the State should pay their own Representatives both their Travel and attendance at the General Court and Desire that Clause providing for their Pay for travel out of the Publick Treasury may be altered 41 voting for this alteration and 8 against it They Desire that the word Protestant may be inserted in the Room of or added to the word, Christian Religion in the Qualifications of the Governor and all other officers both Civil and Military. They also Desire that the Time for Revising the Constitution May not Exceed Seven Years 55 voting for this Alteration none against it

Then The Question was put to the Town whether they did approve of the Constitution, but Desire the foregoing alterations and it passed in the affirmative one dissenting

The Town also voted to empower their Delegate to agree upon a time when the Constitution shall take place

3 article The Town Made Choice of M^r Asher Cutler for a Selectman, and Cap^t Samuel Knight for an Assessor

4th Granted to the Rev^d M^r Jacob Bigelow as a Gratuity for the last half of the Present year the Sum of fifteen Hundred Pounds £ 1500 0 0

5th Granted for the purpose of supplying the families of the Soldiers belonging to this Town Engaged in the Service During the war the Sum of one Thousand Pound £ 1000 0 0 And Ordered the Assessors ^{to make} Said Sumes into a Rate forthwith

Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this Meeting
