The Town by their vote accepted of the warning of this meeting

At a Leagall Town Meeting in Sudbury ~~June~~ May 22 1780

The Town being met at time and place according to the foregoing warning proceeded and Chose Capt Jonathan Rice Moderator then the Town proceeded to the article and Chose the four Select men and James Thompson a Committee to agree with and settle with East Sudbury Relating to a Division as expressed in this article

3 The Town accepted of the List of Jurors as put into the Box by the Select men

4 The Town by their vote Ordered that their Town Meetings shall be warned by the Constables of the Town according to Law notifying each Leagall voter
Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this Meeting

To Mr After Cutter Greeting

I These order you to warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of Sudbury (in the South ward) to meet at the meeting House in Sudbury on Thursday the fiftenth Day of June instant at two of the Clock afternoon on 5 Day then and there

1 To Choose a Moderator

2 To see if the Town will Choose a Committee and Grant money to hire the men to be Raised in this Town to Reinforce the Continental army agreeable to a Resolve of the Great and General Court of this State of the fifth of June instant

3 To see if the Town will appropriate fifteen Hundred Pounds Granted at the Last Town meeting as a Gratuity to the Rev^d Mr Jacob Biglow for the Last half of the present year to som other use as the Town may think proper when met. And Grant the Rev^d Mr Biglow a Reasonable Gratuity as He and for the Last half of the present year as He and the Town Can agree
