Greeting Sir These order you to warn all the freeholders and
other Inhabitants of Sudbury ^{in your ward} Qualified as the Law Directs to vote in Town
affairs to meet at the Meeting House in Said Town on Friday the seventh
Day of July instant at two o' Clock afternoon on 3^d Day thereof there

- 1st To Choose a moderator, and see if the Town will Choose a Committee
and Grant money to hire the men Required of this Town, by the Resolves
of the Great and General Court of this State of the 22 and 23 of June
Last. to Reinforce the Continantal army
- 2^d To see if the Town will Grant money to Enable their Committee to
settle with and fullfill their Engagements with the Two months men to
Rhode Island Last year: and to make up the Deficiency of the Grant to
hire the Last Nine Months men to Reinforce the Continantal army
- 3^d To see if the Town will make an addition to the Committee appointed
at a Late Town meeting to settle with East Sudbury Respecting the
Property of the Town. Donations to the Poor &c, to be Divided betwixt
Each of Said Towns, by an Act of the Great and General Court for
Incorporating Said Town of East Sudbury
- 4th To see if the Town will Order the Assessors, to make all the money
Granted by the Town at this Meeting into a Rate forthwith

And Make Return of this Order with your Doings thereon to the
Select men or Town Clerk at time and place above mentioned
Sudbury July 3^d 1780

The Town voted to accept of the Returns of the Constables and to proceed
to the business set forth in the Order for the Meeting

At a Legall Town Meeting in Sudbury July 7th 1780

The Town being met according to the above warning, they proceeded
and Chose Capt Asahel Wheeler Moderator then the Town proceeded
to the first article

- 1st And appointed the Selectmen of this Town a Committee to hire the
men Required of this Town by the Resolves of the General Court of the
22 & 23 of June Last on the Best termes they Can: And Empowered
Said Com^{tee} to Borrow what money they may agree with said men to
be paid Down and Give Security in behalfe of the Town for the same
on
