- 3 To see if the Town will Grant to their Reverend Minister his Salary for the Year Ensuing and if they will an honourable Gratuity as the Town may think proper for the Ensuing Year
- 4 To see if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of a Grammar School in Said Town the Ensuing Year and Order where Said School shall be kept
- 5 To see if the Town will Grant Money for the Relief of the Poor in said Town the Ensuing Year
- 6 To see if the Town will appoint a Man to take Care of and Sweep the Meeting House in Said Town the Ensuing Year and to Dig Graves as there May be Ocasion
- 7 To see if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of a Reading and writing School in Said Town the present Year and Order where Said School shall be kept
- 8 To see if the Town will appropriate a Sum of Money Refunded to this Town by the State Treasurer for what they had Expended on the families of the Continental Soldiers belonging to this Town to Som Use as the Town may think proper when met
- 9 To see if the Town will accept and approve of the agreement between the Committee appointed by this Town and the Town of East Sudbury for the purpose of agreeing on a Division of all what Ever is to be Divided between Said Towns by an act of the General Court of this State for Incorporating Said Town of E. Sudbury
- 10 To see if the Town will Grant Money to Purchase the Quantity of Beef that this Town is required to furnish by a resolve of the General Court of this State Dated September 25 1780 and Choose a Corp^{se} to purchase Said Beef
- 11 To see if the Town will Grant Money to pay for the Horses purchased by the Selectmen of this Town for the use of the army by Order of a resolve of the General Court of this State
- 12 To see if the Town will make an allowance to Lieut Abijah Brigham for his Service to Doverick and to Lieut Joshua Haynes for his Service at Rhode Island in the present war
- 13 To see if the Town will Grant Money to pay the Assessors and Town Treasurer the present year
- 14 To see if the Town will Grant money to Supply the families of the Soldiers belonging to this Town Engaged in the Service of the United States During the war
- 15 To hear the Report of the Com^{tee} Chosen at a former Town Meeting at the Desire of Col^o Ezekiel How Esq^r Josiah Richardson and m^r John Brigham to view and Judge of the worth of Som Land belonging to this Town which the said Persons Desire to purchase
