Sudbury and agree on this Towns Proportion of the Beef mentioned in this article and Chose Capt^t Asahel Wheeler M^r Benjⁿ Smith and Leiv^t Hopestill Brown a Comtee to Purchase said Beef

Then the Town Adjourned this meeting to Monday the 23 Day of Octo^r Instant at one o^o Clock after noon at the same place
