Sudbury (in your ward) Qualified as the Law Directs to vote
in Town affairs, to meet at the Meeting House in said Town on
Tuesday the Twenty-Sixth Day of December instant at one of the
Clock After noon, on said Day then and there

- 1st To Choose a Moderator and see what measures the Town will take
to raise the Soldiers Required of this Town to fill up the Continental
army, Agreeable to the Resolve of the General Court of this Common-
wealth, Dated, Decem^r 2^d 1780
 - 2^d To see if the Town will Choose a Committee and Grant Money to
purchase the Quantity of Beef Required of this Town for the Use of the
army by the Last Resolves of the General Court of this Commonwealth
for that purpose
 - 3^d To see if the Town will Choose a Committee and Grant money to build a
suitable place to hang the Meeting House Bell; if the Proprietors of
Bell will make a present of the Bell to the Town Agreeable to the Request
of Mr John Maynard and others Proprietors of said Bell
 - 4th To see if the Town will Order how their Town meetings shall be
warned for the future or untill further Orders from the Town and order
the Assessors to make all the money Granted at this meeting into a Rate
for the with
- And Make Return of this Order with your Doings thereon to the Selectmen
or Town Clerk at time and place above mentioned

At a Legall Town Meeting in Sudbury December 26th 1780

138 The Order for the Meeting being Read and the warning being accepted
by the Town Capt Asahel Wheeler was Chosen Moderator then the Town
proceeded as follows

- 1st Chose the following persons a Committee to hire the men Required of this
Town to fill up the Continantal army viz Capt Aaron Haynes Capt
Jonathan Price Capt Asahel Wheeler Mr Isaac Puffer & Jacob Head
Mr John Maynard and 2^d James Puffer or to see on what terms
the men may be Engaged, and to Report to the Town at the adjournment
of this meeting
