

These are to notify and warn all the Freeholders and Other Inhabitants of Sudbury qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs to meet at the Meeting House in Said Town on Monday the Twenty Second Day of January Instant at three o' Clock after noon, on S^d Day then and there

1st To Choose a Moderator, and see if the Town will Choose a Committee and Empower them to bring an Action against or proceed Otherwise in a Course of Law with the Town of Bolton for their Bringing Mary Piper and her Children into Sudbury: She and her Children not being able to support them selves, and not belonging to Sudbury and Grant Money to Carry on Said affair or Act on this Article as the Town May think proper when met.

2^d To see if the Town will Grant Money to make up the Depreciation of the Money that has been Borrowed on the Credit and for the Use of the Town to hire Soldiers into the army by their Committees for that purpose and not yet paid

3^d To see if the Town will Give their Representative Instructions relating to a Bill Pending in the General Court for Repealing or Altering the Tendor Act so Called

At a Legall Town Meeting in Sudbury January 22 1781

The Town being met at time and place according to the foregoing warning proceeded as follows and Chose Capt. Asahel Wheeler Moderator. Then proceeded as follows viz^t

1st article Chose Col^o How Capt Rice, Capt Maynes a Com^{tee} to take the first article under Consideration, and Report to the Town at this Meeting

2^d Granted the Sum of Two Thousand Pounds toward making up the Depreciation of the Money that has been Borrowed for the Use of the Town and not yet paid

139 Then the meeting was Adjourned to M^r Johnsons Then the Com^{tee} Chosen to Consider on the first article Reported to proceed in a Course of Law with the Town of Bolton relating to Mary Piper and Children, which was Complied with by the Town and Chose M^r Asahel Cutler Capt. Asahel Wheeler and M^r Wm Rice a Com^{tee} to Carry on Said affair: and Granted the Sum of One Thousand Pounds to Defray the Charges thereof and Ordered the Assessors to Make this and the Other Sum Granted at this Meeting into a Rate forthwith.
