3. Chose Capt Elijah Smith Capt Jonathan Rice Capt Aaron Haynes Mr Wm Rice Jr and L^d Matthias Mosman a Committee to prepare a Remonstrance against the proceedings of the General Court relating to the Tender Act so Called

Then the Town by their vote Dissolved this meeting

These are to Notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs, to Meet at the Meeting House in Said Town on Monday the fifth Day of March next at one o'Clock after noon on S^d Day then and there

- 1st To Choose a Moderator Select men, Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Assessor Constables, and all other Town Officers as the Law directs to be Chosen annually in the Month of March
- 2^d To see if the Town will Give Liberty for Swine to go at Large in Said Town the present year
- 3^d To see if the Town will Repair their Highway by a Rate the present Year and Grant a Suitable Sum of Money for Repairing the Same, and Order the Assessors to Make it into a Rate forthwith and Empower the Surveyors to be Collectors of Said Rates
- 4th To see if the Town will Grant Liberty for Horses to go at Large without fellers any part of the time from the first Day of April next to the Last Day of September next
- 5th To see if the Town will Give Liberty for Sheep to go at Large any part of the time from the fifteenth Day of March next to the first Day of May next
- 6th To see if the Town will accept of the List of Jurors as they are put into the Box by the Selectmen
- 7th To see if the Town will accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer
- 8th To see if the Town will accept of a Town way Laid out by the Selectmen from the Great County Road at Sandy Hill, to Caleb Wheelers Land (39.1)
- 9th To see if the Town will Adopt the Mode of Classing themselves in Order to raise their Quota of Men to fill up the Continental army. Agreeable to the Resolves of the General Court Dated Decem^r 2^d 1780 or take some other Method to Raise the Men as the Town may think proper when met
- 10th To see if the Town will Choose a Committee to Enquire of the Select men how they have Disposed of the Towns Money Said Comtee to Report to the Town Agreeable to the Motion of Ensign Josiah Richardson and others
