- 13th To see if the Town will accept and Confirm the Agreement of the Committees Chosen by Sudbury and East Sudbury, to Make a Division of all what Ever is to be Divided betwixt Each of said Towns by an Act of the General Court for Incorporating S^d Town of East Sudbury

The Town being met at time and place according to the foregoing warning proceeded and Chose Capt Jonathan Rice Moderator then the Town proceeded and Passed over to the 6th Article and Accepted of the List of Jurors as they are put into the Box by the Select men Then the Town proceeded to the Choice of the following Town Officers

Then the Town took up the 7th Article again and Voted that the Com^{tee} appointed to Class the Town in Order to raise this Towns Quota of Men to fill up the Continental army for the Delay that Business will meet

Tuesday, and by their vote ordered the Town Treasurer to Give Security in behalf of the Town to all such Soldiers as have or may be engaged by said Com^{tee} for the Service aforesaid, for so much and on the same Conditions that they and S^d Com^{tee} have agreed on, to be paid hereafter, as they have agreed And by their vote Ordered the Constables for the Last year to pay to Each of S^d men so much Money as they and the Com^{tee} have agreed shall be paid on their passing Master

Then the Town proceeded to the Choice of the following Town officers viz

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Then the Town Passed over to the 9th Article and Chose Cap^t Jonathan Rice and Cap^t Abel Wheeler a Committee to assist the Spears in Classing the Town and Empowered them to hire this Towns Quota of Men or any part of them Then the Town adjourned this meeting to Wednesday the 14th Day of March instant at one o'clock after noon at the same place
