Agreement between the Com^{tee} of Sudbury and East Sudbury
hereafter recorded and appointed the same Com^{tee} to finish
the Division
Then the Town Adjourned this Meeting to Tuesday the
Twentieth Day of March Instant at one O^l Clock
after noon at the same place

Tuesday March 20th The Town being met according
to Adjournment proceeded as follows

2^d Article Voted to Give Liberty for Swine to go
at Large in Said Town the present year

3^d Voted to Repair their Highways by a Rate the
present year and Granted the Sum of Four
Thousand Pounds for Repairing the same to be
paid in Labour at Thirteen Pounds ten Shillings
per Day for a Man in the Summer Season and
nine pounds per Day after the Last Day of August
and in the same proportion for Teams and Carriages
next And Ordered the Assessors to Make Said
Sum into a Rate forthwith and Empowered
the Surveyors to be Collectors of Said Rates

4th Article passed in the Negative

5th Passed in the Negative

6th Already acted upon as before recorded

7th Accepted of the Settlement of the Selectmen
with the Town Treasurer as hereafter recorded

8th Accepted of the Highway Laid out by the Select
men to Caleb Wheeler's Land

9th article was taken up again and the Town Voted
to Indemnify the Assessors and Militia officers
from any fine that they may incur for not
Obeying the Town agreeable to the resolves
of the General Court. Also Voted to Empower
the Committee Chosen to hire this Towns Quota
of Men to fill up the Continental army to pro-
ceed to hire to hire the Remainder of them on
the Best terms they can at the Towns Cost
