These are to Notify and Warn all the male Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as is provided by the Constitution, to Vote in the Choice of a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, & Senators, and all others Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Meeting House in said Town on Monday 2^d Day of April Next at 2 o'Clock P. Meridien

1 To give in their Votes for a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Counsellors & Senators, for the Year ensuing as directed and provided for by the Constitution

2 To choose a Moderator

3 To give in their Votes for a County Treasurer agreeable to a Warrant to the Select Men directed for the purpose aforesaid

4 To see if the Town will make provision for paying the Depreciation on a Note signed by Capt Rice in behalf of said Town, and payable to Jonas Bemis, or do or act as the Town shall think proper when met

5 To see if the Town will attend to the Reports of their Committee Appointed at a former Meeting in consequence of the Repeal of certain parts of an Act commonly called the Tender Act, and adapt such Measures as they shall think proper when met
