This Notification has been posted up at the Meeting House agreeable to the ^{vote} Order of the Town by order of the Select Men

The Town being met at time and place by their Vote accepted of the warning of this meeting

1st The Town then proceeded to the work of the Day and chose Capt ~~Asahel~~ Asahel Wheler to serve for and represent said Town in a Great and General Court appointed to be convened held and kept for the Government's service at the State House in Boston on Wednesday the thirtieth day of May Inst agreeable to a Law of this Commonwealth in that Case made and provided, but he declining the service the Town at his desire dismissed him therefrom & then chose Capt Asahel Wheler for the purpose aforesaid.

2nd Then the Town chose Capt Asahel Wheler for their Moderator

Then the Town by their Vote took up the Third Article and Granted the sum of five thousand pounds for the support of the poor in said Town

4th Article the Appointed the Select men a Committee to examine the Accounts of the Committees referred to in this Article also to enquire of the Constables whether those persons who have demanded upon the Town for moneys lent for the purpose referred to in this Article — paid their Rates before they refused to receive the Nominal sum lent — and to report at the adjournment of this Meeting

Then the Town by their Vote adjourned this meeting to Monday of 28th Inst at 4 o'clock after noon at this place

May 28 the Town being met according to adjournment proceeded and took up the second Article and ordered their Committee to meet the Committee of East Sudbury, if an opportunity offered, in order to complete the settlements

the settlements referred to in this Article

4th Article passed over for the present

5th Article chose the Select Men a Committee for the

Then the Town adjourned this meeting to Monday of 25 of June next at 4 o'clock after noon at this place
