In obedience to the within order I have warned & caused to be warned all the freholders and other inhabitants in my ward as the Law directs

The return of the other Constable was as the Law directs & the town by their Vote accepted the warning of this meeting - - -

28 June 1781 The Town being met at time and place agreeable to the foregoing warning provided and chose Capt Aaron Haynes their Moderator - then the town by their Vote dismissed their former Committee - - -

Then the town reconsidered their Vote for dismissing their former Committee & Voted to make an addition of three Men to sd Committee & chose Mr Tho Walker, Capt Dan Bowker and Mr Asaph Cutler in addition to sd Committee - then the town dismissed Mr Asaph Cutler & chose Lt

145 Asaph Cutler in his room & ordered sd Committee to attend the business of hiring the towns Quota of men as required for three years without loss of time & if the men cannot be obtained in town then to apply elsewhere and granted one hundred & fifty pound in specie to enable their Committee to accomplish the business & ordered the selectmen to make the same into a rate forth with - also ordered their Committee to hire
